Culture Topics & Activities	Arabic culture explicitly and implicitly taught: Simulated “Arab” village; courtesy expressions, songs, dance, arts, crafts, Arab food, Arabic language signs <u>two-week daily schedule</u> <u>two-week curriculum</u> Repetition, choral drilling, some individual and pair work
Assessment & Evaluation	mid-session progress reports, villager portfolios, CLVisa – a language-specific self-assessment (adaptation of LinguaFolio), credit teacher assessments based on tests, quizzes, one-on-one discussions with their e-mentees (StarTalk recipients) and the StarTalk villagers villager portfolios and reflective activities
