❖ Standards and Expected Outcomes

What will students know and be able to do in the target language and culture? Identify what students will do in terms of the standards. Ideally, all standards will be addressed, but there may be exceptions depending on the type of program that is being offered.

Standards Targeted	Students Can
Communication - Interpretive	<p>Introduction to the family module (family tree)</p> <p>Native Speakers will talk about their families and students will record the information in a chart.</p> <p>Students will report on the similarities and differences between the families.</p>
Communication - Interpersonal	<p>Students will brainstorm questions for a survey and then conduct</p> <p>The survey among their classmates to determine who has the largest family, the smallest family, and what the average family size is.</p> <p>They will then compare this information with what was learned from the Hindi native speakers.</p>
Communication - Presentational	<p>Students will explore a Geni family tree and create their own presentation about their families and present it to the class.</p>

Cultural Practices/Products/Perspectives	The Nehru Dynasty.
Connections	Students will learn about joint families in India and why families live together by watching a Bollywood video and identifying key words to describe what they saw.
Comparisons	The Nehru Dynasty in India and The Kennedy and Bush Dynasty in America American families vs Indian Families- Based on Tradition and Culture
Community	Students will post family info to Ning for global partners.

Understand the family dynamics of other families	By doing a survey and asking each other about the size of their families
Comprehend the structure of joint families	By watching clips of Bollywood movies
